## County Approval Status and Accreditation

To ensure each county board of education provides a thorough and efficient education for its students, the West Virginia Board of Education (WVBE) shall annually review county scorecards and efficiency profiles provided by the Office of Support & Accountability. County status will be reviewed and determined based on multiple measures of student performance and county operational efficiency.

The WVBE will review annually the information submitted by the West Virginia Department of Education (WVDE) and issue each county board of education an approval status. W. Va. §18-2E-5 (I) School system approval — The state board annually shall review the information submitted for each school system from the system of education performance measures and issue to each county board an approval status in compliance with federal law and established by state board rule. As part of the West Virginia Accountability System (WVAS) outlined in WVBE Policy 2322: West Virginia System of Support and Accountability, county status will be reviewed annually to determine two accountability measures:

- County Operational Effectiveness Indicators of Efficiency Counties will receive a rating of *Meets Requirements* or *Needs Assistance* on each of the 11 efficiency indicators. A rating of *Needs Assistance* indicates the county, with assistance from the WVDE, must develop an action plan and monitor the plan's implementation towards showing improvement. Further support or corrective actions by the West Virginia Board of Education may be taken based on the county's acceptable progress or lack of progress on the indicator(s).
- West Virginia Balanced Scorecard Indicators of Student Performance and Success In 2023, counties will be identified based on two consecutive years of data. Counties can receive designations of **Support** and/or **On Watch** on the Balanced Scorecard indicators.
  - » A county-level indicator that receives **Does Not Meet Standard** and does not show improvement for **TWO** consecutive years will result in the county being designated as **Support** for the indicator. Actions include the WVDE assisting county leadership, providing technical assistance, and monitoring progress. Counties with three or more Support indicators, with the exception of English Learners, shall report to the WVBE the plan to address deficiencies.
  - » A county-level indicator that receives **Does Not Meet Standard** will result in the county being designated as **On Watch** for the indicator. Actions include the county diagnosing and facilitating countywide improvement, verifying the strategic plan addresses the deficiencies, and monitoring for progress. The following year's Balanced Scorecard data will be used to determine whether improvement did or did not occur.
