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ABSTRACT

This material, developed from current State Department of Education Certification Bulletins, is presented in a manner which makes it possible to gain significant information concerning certification requirements for guidance counselors in all 50 states and the District of Columbia. The format of the tables provides both general information as well as specific, peculiar data concerning each state's requirements. Comparisons among states are readily determinable. The final tables list, by both the number and percent those states which: (1) require recommendations from degree-granting institutions; (2) require some years of teaching experience; (3) allow other work experience; (4) require degrees; and (5) require a certain number of hours in guidance. The information is seen as useful in evaluating trends in counselor preparation and certification. (Author/TL)

  3. California requires sixty semester hours of post-baccalaureate work; however, three years of full-time classroom teaching may substitute for half of these hours.

  5. Item 6a required for elementary counselors who have not taught in elementary school or have not had course in reading. Area V4 required for elementary counselors.
  6. New Mexico requires Area IE.
  7. Rhode Island requires a course in Rhode Island Education in addition to other hours listed.
  8. Utah - State Teacher Certification or completion of a prior approved internship under the supervision of a professional counselor.
  9. Washington - No specific course requirements listed.
  10. Wyoming - Degree and work experience option - Master in an academic area complemented by sufficient course work in counselor education courses so as to be the equivalent of a Master in Guidance. One year of work experience or successful completion of a course in the Philosophy of Vocational Education.
  11. Wyoming lists no specific course requirements but does list hours required.
