Focuses on the concept that people are what they are because of the values they live by, that when you're young it seems like you're living by someone else's values, and that your parents seem to be saying, "No, don't do that!" most of the time. But that as you grow you must decide what you want, enjoy, and want to be, if you don't want to drift or have others with stronger values run your life. Values make the difference.

Needs time to show and allow for discussion. Begins with comments on how young people feel their parents' negative reactions to what they often do. Comments that while even heroes like Lincoln are not perfect, while war heroism may only result in death, there are positive values involved and no need for cynicism. Because of negative focus on parents and national heroes, care should be taken to orient adult audiences to the filmstrip and allow for discussion afterwards.
