ABSTRACT

This library handbook is an informal guide for the student studying the German language and literature. It lists reference materials basic to general research and gives their locations in the Fogler Library at the University of Maine. Reference works for study of the language include (1) dictionaries and encyclopedias, (2) histories of the language, and (3) style manuals. Materials relating to the literature include (1) guides and bibliographies, (2) histories of the literature, and (3) bibliographical dictionaries. Some entries are briefly annotated.
