**ABSTRACT**

The results of studies on services for hearing impaired persons in state psychiatric hospitals and mental health programs, the directory lists approximately 100 programs and resources for hearing impaired persons in 27 states (and two listings in Canada). Arranged alphabetically by state, citations include information on director's name, services offered, program capacity, professional staff, and date the program was established. Programs (mental health services units specifically designed for hearing impaired persons, and typically housed in psychiatric hospitals, mental health clinics, or schools) are represented as well as resources (specific agencies or private practitioners not designed specifically for, but offering services to, the hearing impaired).

To the Reader:

This 1981 Directory of Mental Health Programs and Resources for Hearing Impaired Persons is the first product to result from two studies conducted by the Gallaudet Research Institute. The first study, conducted with support from the National Institute of Mental Health, sought to describe services for hearing impaired patients in state psychiatric hospitals and other clinical facilities throughout the country. The second study focused on identifying and describing mental health services for hearing impaired children, some of which are located in agencies other than those which provide services to adults. This Directory, therefore, encompasses a broad spectrum of institutions and individuals who have indicated that they provide mental health services to hearing impaired persons. It was not our purpose, nor was it within our capability, to evaluate programs or to verify in any sense the information they reported to us. We have simply listed here the relevant program information as provided to us by representatives of the program or practitioner.

This Directory is organized alphabetically by state, then subdivided into programs and resources. Programs were defined as mental health service units specifically designed to render clinical services to hearing impaired persons in need of mental health treatment. Typically they are a part of a psychiatric hospital, a mental health clinic, or a school program. Resources were defined as specific agencies or private practitioners which are not formally organized specifically as a mental health facility for hearing impaired persons, but who routinely admit hearing impaired individuals for clinical services. The information presented in this Directory pertains to the programs or services for hearing impaired patients only, not to the services or programs of the larger, host institution which supports the program for hearing impaired persons.

The information about the mental health programs and resources in this Directory is presented in five categories, as follows:

- The Director is the identified head, coordinator, or director of the service unit for deaf persons, or the identified resource individual to contact regarding services for hearing impaired persons.
- The Services provided are described as type of service, population served and patient status.

Type of Service offered may include therapy, day treatment, special education for emotionally disturbed hearing impaired children, counseling, or halfway house services. Consultation and evaluation services are generally available from programs and resources although not specifically identified as specific services by most respondents. Units designed to serve a population with multiple handicapping conditions, such as mental retardation in addition to deafness, are identified as such.

Population Served was identified as children, adolescents, or adults.

Patient Status is described as in-patient or out-patient status for clinical facilities, and as residential or day status for educational facilities.

- Program Capacity ordinarily indicates the number of patients the program or resource serves when operating at full capacity. Some programs preferred to indicate an annual, monthly, or current census figure at the time of the survey. When this is the case, the appropriate qualifier appears in parentheses following the program capacity figure.
- The Professional Staff listing reports the number of full-time and part-time individuals working in the program within the following professional fields: physicians, psychologists, social workers, nurses, teachers, specialized therapists, and interpreters.
- The Year the Program was Established indicates the date of initiation of special services for hearing impaired persons.

We hope this Directory will be of service to you in your work. If you require more specific information about any program or resource individual, please contact that program or individual directly.
