ABSTRACT

This directory provides 227 listings of Hispanic women in psychology living in the United States (they are found in 21 states plus the District of Columbia) and Puerto Rico. The entries, which are alphabetically listed, identify each woman's highest degree earned, date of degree, institution where the degree was earned, areas of specialization of highest degree, areas of current interest and expertise, current work activities, work affiliation, home address, phone number, and professional affiliations. Following the alphabetical listings is a geographical index (by State) and an index which identifies the persons listed by areas of specialization of highest degree. (CJM)

Division 35 publishes a Newsletter and sponsors a division journal, The Psychology of Women Quarterly, which all division members receive. INTRODUCTION

This Directory of Hispanic Women in Psychology is an initial step in addressing the need for the communication and collaboration among Hispanic women. The first goal of the Directory is to promote communication among Hispanic women in psychology by providing a resource guide which will identify who we are as well as our areas of expertise. It is hoped that individuals will take the initiative to utilize this directory to establish contact with others conducting work in similar areas of interest and geographic regions.

In addition, the Directory is intended to serve as a resource for individuals and institutions seeking the psychological expertise of Hispanic women living in the United States and Puerto Rico. Thus, the second goal of the Directory is to facilitate the integration of professional expertise of Hispanic women into professional organizations, academic institutions, community and government agencies, and private industry. Individuals and institutions needing the expertise of Hispanic women in psychology will now have a reference guide that will aid them in identifying experts in their areas of interest. It is our hope that such individuals and institutions will make frequent use of the Directory in their attempt to incorporate in their activities a psychological perspective which adequately represents ethnic minority communities and women.

The Directory provides 227 listings of Hispanic women living in the United States and Puerto Rico. They are found in 21 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. Seventy-eight percent of the women identified reside in five states and Puerto Rico: California (38), Massachusetts (34), New York (34), Florida (27), Puerto Rico (26), and Texas (17). Twelve fields are represented. Fifty-five percent of the women represented listed clinical psychology as the area of specialization for their highest degree (124); thirty percent listed counseling/community psychology (68), and eleven percent listed developmental psychology (26).

The entries, which are alphabetically listed, identify each woman's highest degree earned, date of degree, institution where the degree was earned, areas of specialization of highest degree, areas of current interest and expertise, current work activities, work affiliation, home address, phone number, and professional affiliations. Following the alphabetical listings is a geographical index which identifies the listings by state and an index which identifies the listings by areas of specialization of highest degree.

The professionals whose names appear in the Directory are those who responded to one of a variety of outreach strategies. Dissemination of information about the Directory included: 1) mailings to individuals in non-published rosters of Hispanic psychologists and mental health professionals compiled by local and national groups and organizations, 2) mailings to individuals referred to us by those who had responded to the

Directory announcements, 3) announcements in Hispanic professional network publications, and 4) communication with major Hispanic research and service centers.

If you are interested in being in the Directory and/or are able to provide names of Hispanic women not presently listed, please complete the information sheet at the back of this publication and return it to the address stated on the form immediately. Your name will be listed in a Directory addendum. If you are presently listed and would like to update or correct information in the listing, you should use the information sheet to note any changes.

The first edition of this Directory issued in August 1983, contained 170 listings. The current Directory contains 227. It is still not considered a complete source of all Hispanic women in psychology living in the United States and Puerto Rico; however, we consider that it represents the majority of active Hispanic women in the field. As the Directory is disseminated, increasing numbers of Hispanic women in psychology become identified. In order to provide an opportunity to those not presently listed in the Directory to be included, an up-to-date addendum will be maintained in the Women's Programs Office.
