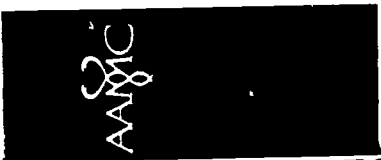

ABSTRACT

This publication provides statistical data concerning the distribution of approximately 85 percent of all active full-time U.S. medical school faculty, as reported by the schools themselves. Tables and figures present data concerning the overall faculty distribution by sex, ethnicity, rank, degree, and age. In addition, rank and degree distributions are presented according to ethnicity, age, and department, and these statistics are then further broken out by sex and presented in the category distributions of rank and tenure status, ethnicity and rank, ethnicity and degree, ethnicity and department, and degree and department. Additional tables list faculty distribution in postdoctoral research training by degree and department, Medical Doctor faculty by primary specialty, and the distribution of U.S. medical school faculty by specialty/subspecialty and by sex. The publication concludes with a list of 74 public and 52 private institutions by U.S. region. (GLR)

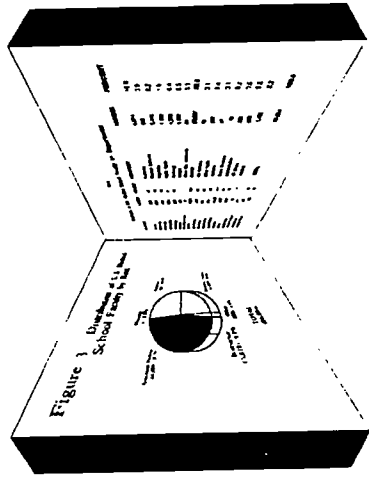

The Faculty Roster System's U. S. Medical School Faculty, 1992 is compiled to serve as a quick reference source answering some of the most frequently asked questions about U. S. medical school faculty.

Proper use of this book requires that several caveats be noted.

1. The data contained in the Faculty Roster database are updated daily. The information contained in this book was compiled in June, 1992.
2. The data are reported voluntarily by the schools and thus reflect school-to-school differences in timeliness and consistency of reporting.
3. The database contains records for approximately 85 percent of all active full-time U. S. medical school faculty. The 15 percent undercount should be taken into consideration when using the data.

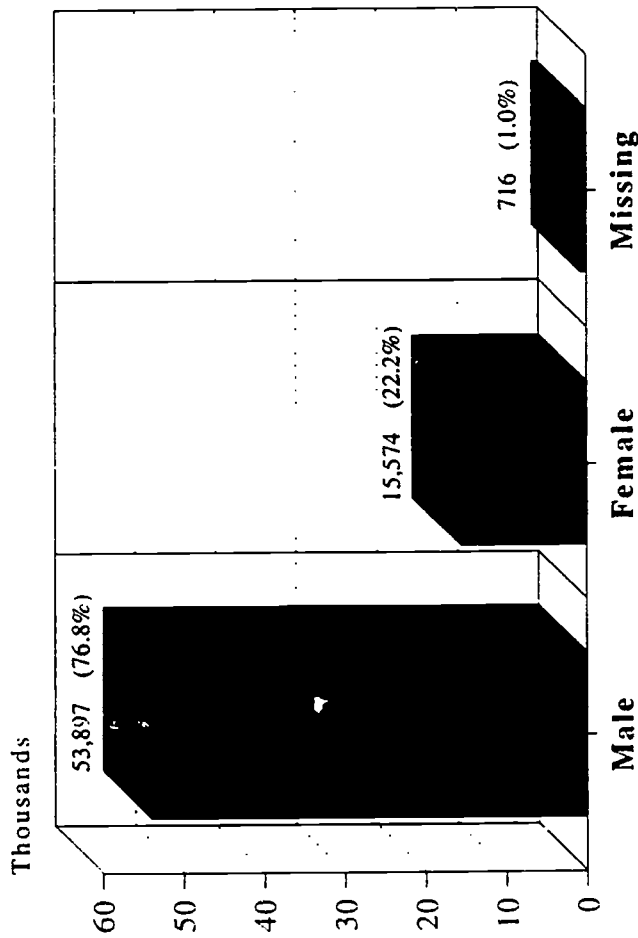

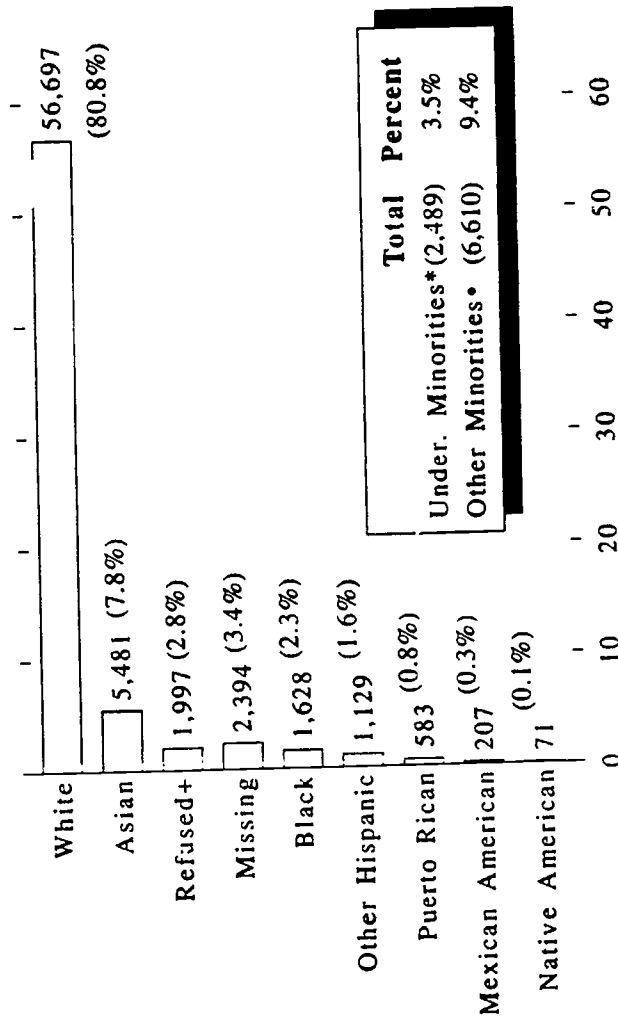

Figure 2: Distribution of U.S. Medical School Faculty by Ethnicity

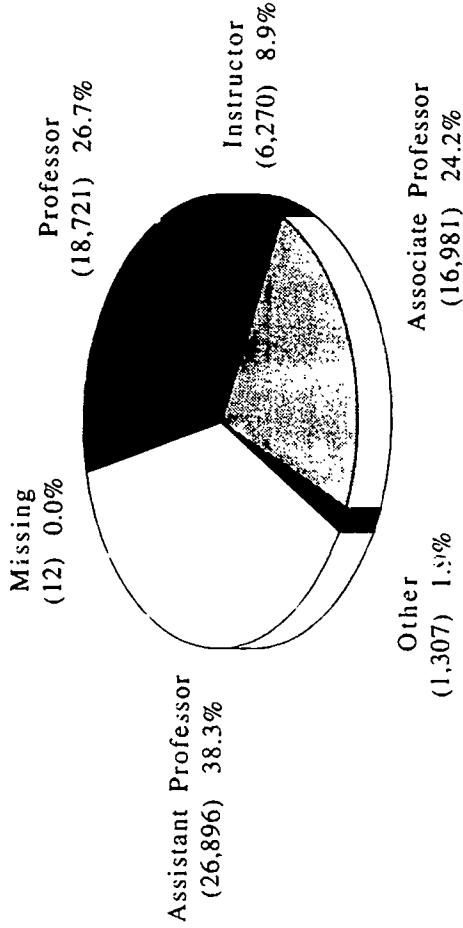

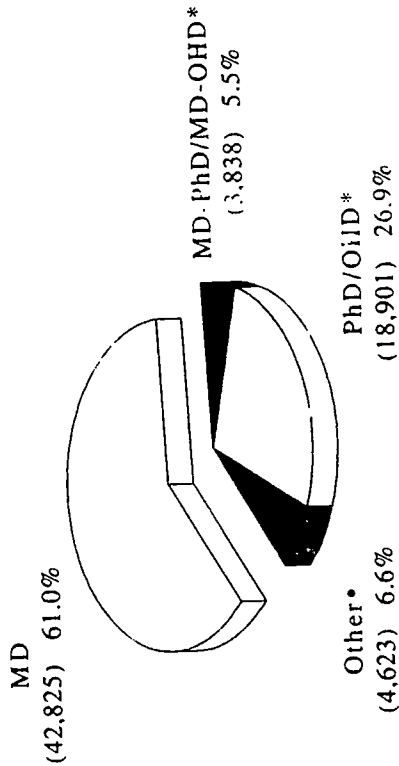

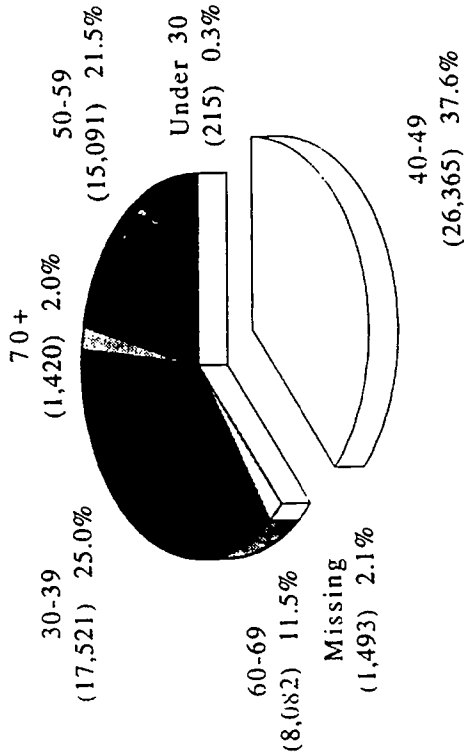
Figure 4: Distribution of U.S. Medical School Faculty by Degree

Figure 6A: Distribution of U.S. Medical School Faculty by Sex and Ethnicity

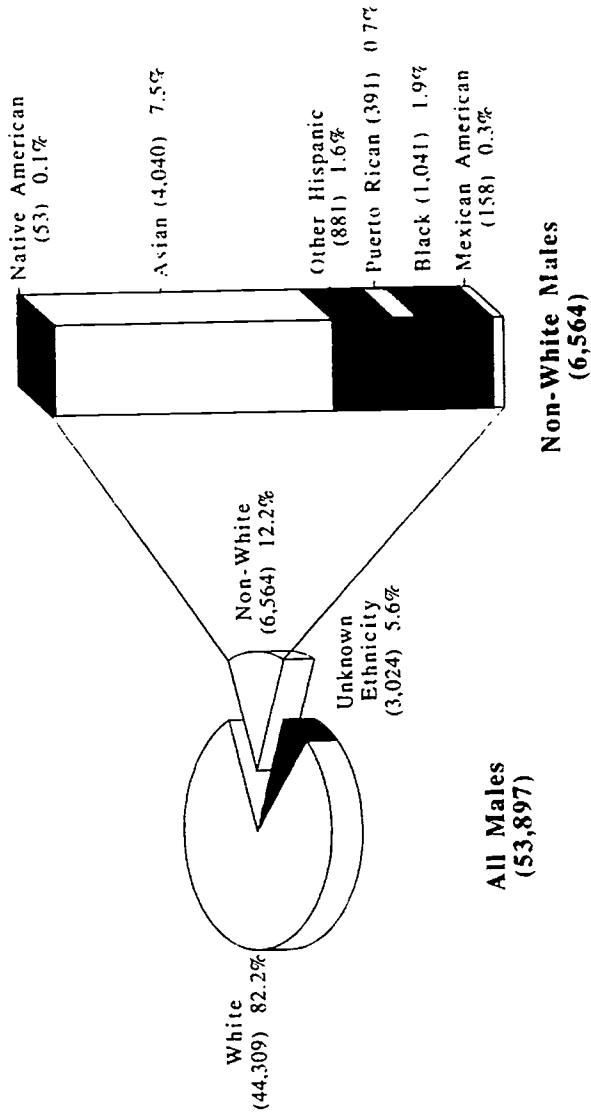
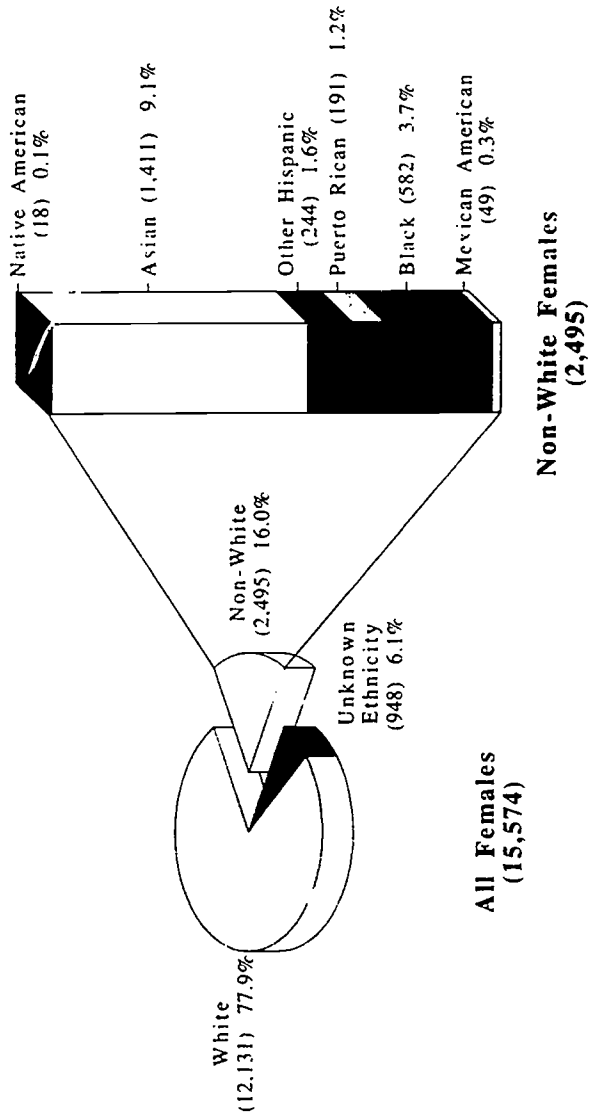
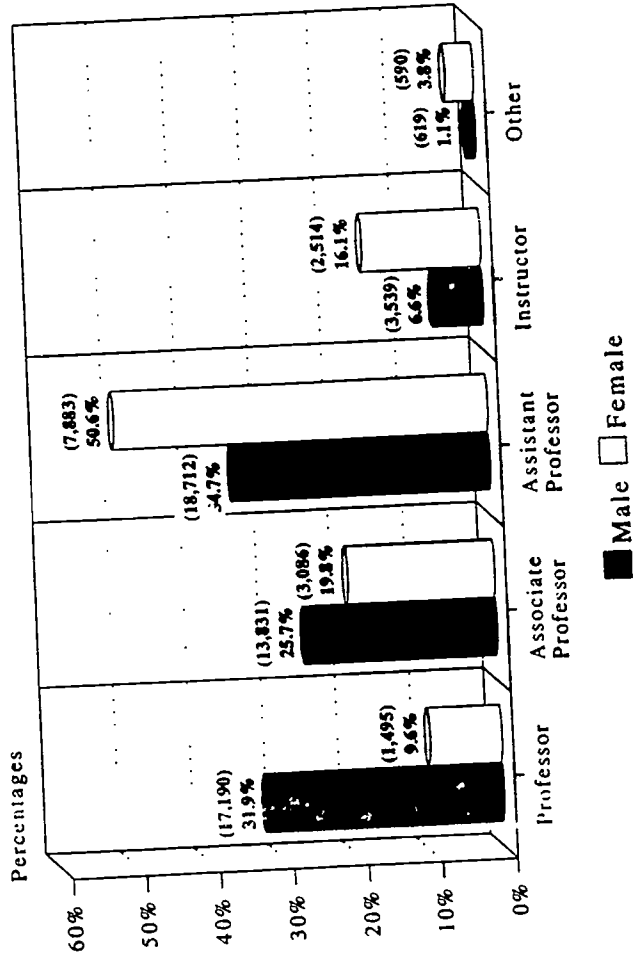


Figure 6B: Distribution of U.S. Medical School Faculty by Sex and Ethnicity

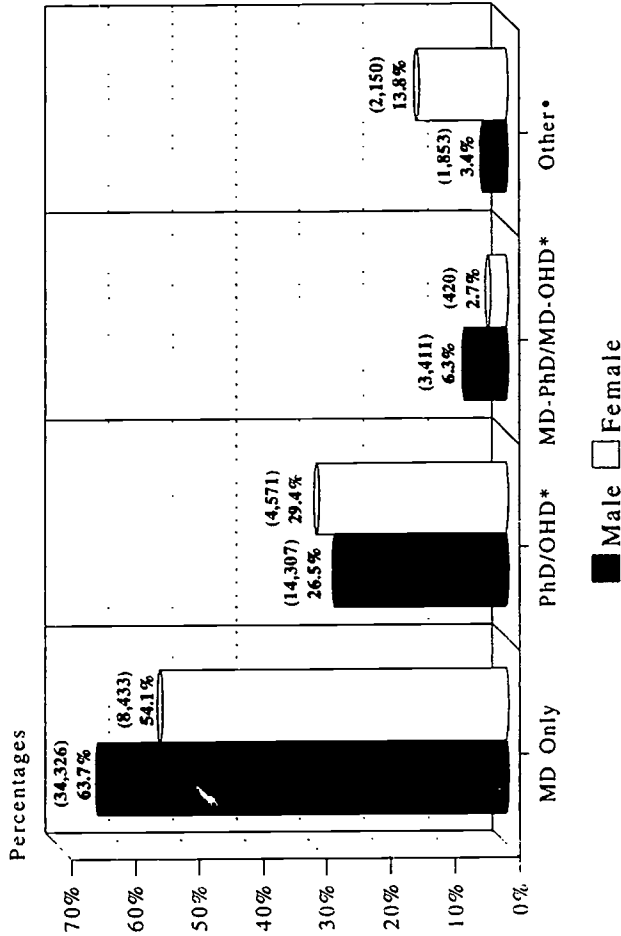
Figure 7: Distribution of U.S. Medical School Faculty by Sex and Rank

Figure 9: Distribution of U.S. Medical School Faculty by Sex and Age

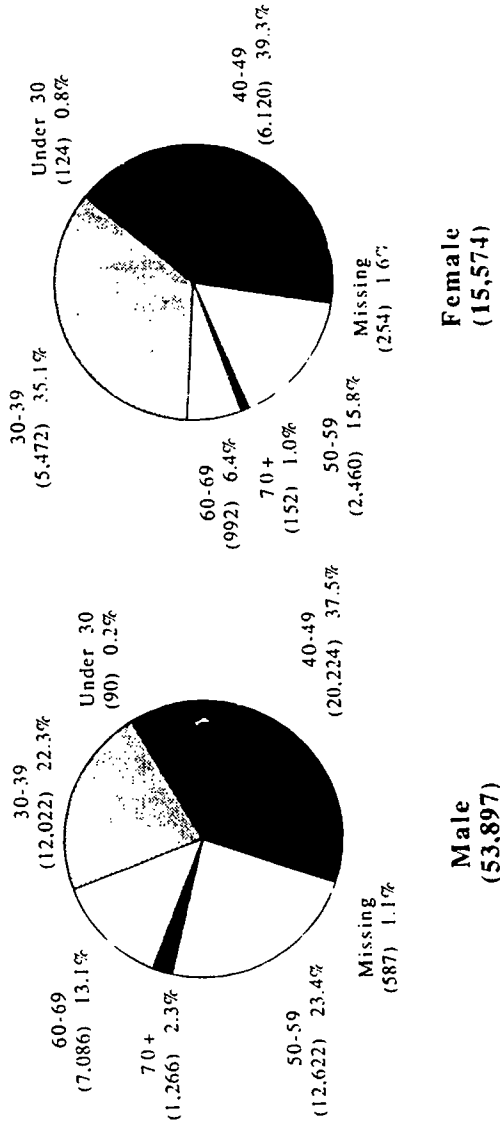


Figure 10: Distribution of U.S. Medical School Faculty by Public/Private Institution and Region

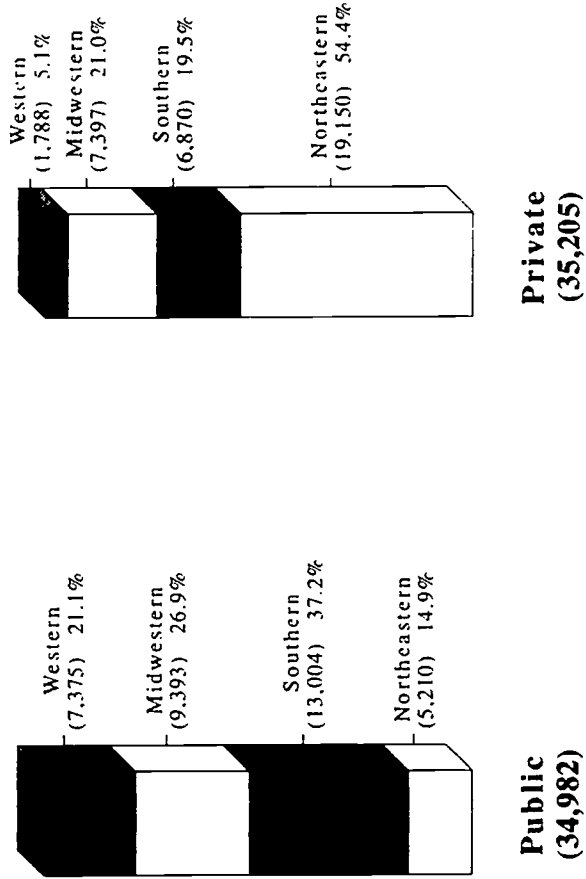
