ABSTRACT

This resource guide was compiled as an aid to education libraries (i.e., libraries that support teacher training and education). It is intended as a tool for teachers, administrators, professors, students of education, and librarians. The focus of the listing, which covers the most important and useful electronic resources currently available in the field, is on elementary and secondary education, including special education, bilingual education, child development, and exceptional child education; resources in the areas of child abuse, mental health, and sociology are also included. A total of 35 resources are divided into 6 major categories: education specific sources, interdisciplinary sources, directory sources, sources of foreign materials, sources of assessment, and participatory sources. Information on the provider, type of database, file size, timespan covered, update frequency, target audience, database content, sources of information, availability, and print counterpart is presented for each resource. Internet resources and education journals online are also listed, and a directory of 29 providers and 13 vendors is included. A list of 8 sources used to compile the guide and 13 sources for further reading and assessment completes the document. (ALF)

## ELECTRONIC RESOURCES IN EDUCATION

This resource guide was compiled as an aid to education libraries. That is, libraries which support teacher training and education. It is a valuable tool for teachers, administrators, professors, and students of education, as well as for librarians. The focus of the listing is on primary and secondary education rather than higher education. The guide includes special education, bilingual education, child development, and exceptional child education.

Libraries which support education and educational research must consider many types of sources for collection development. They should collect in the sciences, social sciences, and humanities, as well as education specific sources such as text-books, curriculum materials, and monographs and serials in education. In order to accommodate such a wide variety of materials, the scope of this resource guide goes beyond educational sources and lists resources in the areas of child abuse, mental health, sociology, etc. I've divided the resources into 7 major categories: education specific sources, interdisciplinary sources, directory sources, sources of foreign materials, sources of assessment, participatory sources, and resources on the Internet. I've chosen to include 3 resources covering Canadian and British materials for four reasons: they are in English, they are easier to associate with in terms of geographic proximity (as opposed to Australia and New Zealand), and they are important resources within their own countries. Also, the research that goes on these and other countries cannot be overlooked, and is useful for comparative analysis.

The primary language used in each of these resources is English. I've specified the language in the few cases otherwise. The target audience of each resource is also specified only

if it varies from my defined user group: teachers, administrators, librarians, professors of and students of education.

The resource guide has a few limits. First of all, although it is comprehensive, it does not cover the entire universe of educational materials. However, there is quite a bit of overlap where some sources look like others or encompass others entirely. I chose to list such sources because certain libraries may use one vendor, covering a specific resource while another library may use a different vendor, which carries the overlapping resource. Therefore, availability becomes broadened.

I've chosen not to include pricing which changes often and becomes confusing, especially when many different vendors with their own pricing structures carry the same resource. Instead, I've included a list of providers and vendors addresses and phone numbers so one can get up to date information on pricing. Also, the Internet section of this guide is not comprehensive. With little written documentation, it is difficult to discover exactly what exists on the Internet. However, the listing I've provided is probably enough to get one started on the Internet where more resources will become apparent.

Finally, I've tried to cover the limits of CD-ROMS and Print as opposed to the databases. I did not compare differences in search strategy or facility in searching, however. Rather, I discussed update frequency and timespan covered. It may be easier or harder for someone to search a database, depending on their experience and expertise.

I've compiled Electronic Resources in Education in order to ease the arduous process of locating important electronic resources in the field of education. This comprehensive listing covers the most important and useful resources available at this time.

**Database Description:** This database provides full bibliographic descriptions on nonprint media for education in all fields and at all levels. These materials exist in the following media: 16mm films, 35mm filmstrips, motion picture cartridges, videotapes, overhead transparencies, phonograph records, audiotapes, slides, and compact discs.

The database also differs from the print source in that it is searchable in full text and each citation is displayed with its distributor and address.
