ABSTRACT

This annotated bibliography contains publication data and information on the content and availability of 58 resource materials that are recommended for use in vocational preparation programs for individuals with limited English proficiency. Descriptions of the resource materials are organized into sections on the following topics: English as a Second Language (ESL), career guidance, vocational training, vocational English as a Second Language, and workplace literacy. Each resource description contains some or all of the following: record number; title; author; editors; edition; publisher; place of publication; month/year of publication; price; location; ERIC code; format; source of information about the resource material; and description of the resource material's content, intended audience, and intended/recommended use(s). Included among the types of resource materials listed are the following: software/courseware, bibliographies, textbooks, teacher guides/handbooks, picture cards, practice books, inventories, test batteries, and videos. Materials for use in secondary-level and adult basic education programs are described. Also included is information about the ESL Resource Center database and various codes used in the database. ESL RESOURCE CENTER DATABASE DESCRIPTION

This database is designed to be a compilation of reference materials and resources available concerning specific areas of education for limited English proficient (LEP) adults. The database allows one to enter keywords on a subject and returns any matching references contained in the database to be printed to the screen. The resources encompassed in the database are given bibliographic **format** codes that tell the user whether the keyword match is a student text, a journal, a video, software, etc. (a complete list of the bibliographic format codes are given on page 3).

Other characteristics specific to the directory entries of the reference materials database include a location code. Each resource housed in the library is tagged with a **location** code representing its location. In remaining consistent with APA style format, the following entries are included with each resource: author(s), information regarding editors/compiler(s)/et al, year and month of publication, title, edition and series information, place of publication, and publisher(s). If applicable and available the ERIC DRS No. (ERIC Document Reproduction Service No.) is provided. Remaining entries include an annotation, price information, special ordering information, and keyword(s). Each resource is allowed a maximum of 5 keywords to categorize the entry for searching purposes.

HOW TO FIND MATERIALS IN THE ESL RESOURCE CENTER

Each of the resource materials in our collection is labeled with a record number, bibliographic **format** code and a **location** code (see page 3). The materials are cataloged in numerical order from left to right on each shelf. The following is an example of the label you will find on each material:
