ABSTRACT

This publication provides basic descriptive information about the 100 largest school districts in the United States and its outlying areas. Almost one in every four public school students in the country is served by one of these districts. They are distinguished from smaller districts by characteristics other than sheer size, such as average and median school size, pupil-teacher ratios, numbers of high school graduates, numbers of students receiving special education services, and minority enrollment as a proportion of total enrollment. The 100 largest districts employ 19.9% of the nation's public school teachers and account for 16.6% of the nation's schools and 19.2% of its high school graduates. Almost all of these districts encompass large cities, but only about half are confined to the city limits. Three states, Florida, Texas, and California, accounted for over one-third of these districts. More than half of these districts have over 50% minority enrollment. Current expenditures per pupil in the 100 largest school districts ranged from a low of \$2,052 in the Puerto Rican Department of Education to a high of \$9,501 in Newark, New Jersey Public Schools. This information is found in 10 basic tables, which are preceded by 3 text tables that establish the context for the information on the 100 largest districts. Appendixes list the largest districts, provide some identifying information, and list the districts alphabetically. (SLD)

Highlights

The information provided in this publication was reported by state education agency officials to the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) for the Common Core of Data (CCD). It relates to student membership in public schools and school districts in the United States and outlying areas during the 1993-94 school year, and to revenues and expenditures for fiscal year 1993.

- The 100 largest public school districts, representing less than 1 percent of all school districts in the nation, were responsible for the education of 23 percent of all public school students.
- The 100 largest districts employed 19.9 percent of the nation's public school teachers, and accounted for 16.6 percent of all public schools and 19.2 percent of public high school graduates.
- Schools in the 100 largest districts were on the average 38.4 percent larger than the average American school and had a slightly higher pupil-teacher ratio than schools in other school districts.
- Although almost all of these districts encompassed large cities, as indicated by the districts' names, only about half of the school districts were confined to the city limits.
- Three states, Florida, Texas, and California, accounted for over one-third of these districts.
- Among the 20 largest districts, five have increased in size by 25 percent or more since 1986: Broward, Dade, Orange, and Palm Beach Counties in Florida, and Clark County in Nevada. Conversely, Detroit City, Chicago, and Puerto Rico have experienced declines in membership since 1986.
- All of the 100 largest districts reported racial/ethnic data. Among them, more than half (54) had over 50 percent minority enrollment. However, in 24 of the 100 districts no single racial/ethnic group comprised a majority of the student population.
- Current expenditures per pupil in the 100 largest school districts ranged from a low of \$2,052 in the Puerto Rico Department of Education to a high of \$9,501 in Newark, New Jersey Public Schools.

Introduction

This publication provides basic descriptive information about the 100 largest school districts in the United States and its outlying areas. Almost one in every four public school students in this nation is served by one of these largest districts. They are distinguished from smaller districts by characteristics in addition to sheer size, such as average and median school size, pupil-teacher ratios, number of high school graduates, number of pupils receiving special education services, and minority enrollment as a proportion of total enrollment. This information is found in the ten basic tables. Three text tables precede the basic tables for the purpose of establishing a meaningful context for the information on the 100 largest districts. Following the basic tables, appendix A lists the 500 largest school districts with some identifying information and basic statistical data. Appendix B is an alphabetical list of the 500 districts indicating their rank by size.

This is the seventh in the current series of reports on the largest school districts in the Nation. The most recently previously published report is *Characteristics of the 100 Largest Public School Districts in the United States: 1992-93*, which was published in October 1995. Overview of Largest Districts

In the 1993-94 school year there were 16,365 local education agencies in the United States and its outlying areas, 14,886 of which were categorized as "regular school districts" (tables A and B). The others were a variety of agencies providing special services (such as regional vocational/technical or special educational) to other public elementary and secondary education agencies.

The 100 largest school districts served 10,138,769 students, or 23 percent of the total public elementary and secondary school population of over 44 million students in more than 16,000 local education agencies (LEAs) in the Nation (table A). The largest school district in the country is the New York City Public Schools, with 1,005,521 students in 1,064 schools. The second largest is the Los Angeles Unified School District, with 639,129 students in 640 schools. The Puerto Rico Department of Education, with 631,460 students in 1,584 schools, is third in size (table 1). The 500 largest districts (3.1 percent of all school districts) serve 18,701,272 students, or 42.4 percent of the total public elementary and secondary school student population in the United States (table A).

For a more comprehensive picture of the distribution of school districts of all sizes nationally and the numbers of students served, see table B or consult the related data sources listed at the end of the text.

Where Are the 100 Largest School Districts?

The District of Columbia, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico each has only one school district for the entire jurisdiction, and each is represented among the 100 largest districts (table 1). Alaska, Illinois, Indiana, Kansas, Kentucky, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, New

Jersey, New Mexico, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Washington, and Wisconsin each have one district among the 100 largest. States with multiple districts among the 100 largest are Texas with 14; Florida with 13; California with 11; Georgia and Maryland with 5 each; Louisiana, North Carolina, Tennessee, and Virginia with 4 each; Ohio, and Utah with 3 each; and Alabama, Arizona, Colorado, Nevada, New York, and South Carolina with 2 each.

As expected, these 100 school districts tend to be in cities and counties having large populations, with administrative offices typically located in large cities and their environs. Many of the districts are in states where school districts are coterminous with counties. The district names indicate that 45 of these districts are identified with cities, 46 with counties or parishes, and 9 with other jurisdictions. About 70 percent of these districts are located in coastal states, although several are located in the large cities of the north-central states.

How Do These Districts Compare With the Average School District?

General Characteristics

According to information submitted to the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) by education officials in state education agencies, the average school district in America has 5.3 schools, 144.3 teachers, and 2,693.4 students, with an average school size of about 506 students and a mean pupil-teacher ratio of 18.7 to 1 (table A). Among the 100 largest districts, the means are 144.7 schools, 4,705.6 teachers, and 101,387.9 students, yielding an average school size of 700.5 and a pupil-teacher ratio of 21.5 to 1.

Nationally, the number of high school graduates per year as a percentage of total school membership is 5.1 percent. For the 100 largest school districts the average is 4.3 percent (table A).

Student Body Composition

A substantial number of these districts have a disproportionately high percentage of racial/ethnic minorities in their pupil population, compared with the average school district. Using school district data from the Office for Civil Rights for 1992-93, NCES estimates that in 1992-93 the 100 largest districts, with about 23 percent of the nation's pupils, had slightly more than 40 percent of the 13.7 million minority students in the country. For all 100 largest districts school-level student racial/ethnic data are reported in the 1993-94 CCD files.*

Forty-six districts report 50 percent or more of their students as white, non-Hispanic (table 9). Of these 46 districts, 16 report minority representation of less than 25 percent of their student body, and 10 of them have less than 20 percent minority students (table 8).

In 22 districts, half or more of the membership is black, non-Hispanic; 7 districts report that the majority of their students are Hispanic; and in one district, most of the students are

*The numbers of students in different racial/ethnic categories are reported on the school universe survey of the Common Core of Data (CCD), and these school-level numbers are then aggregated to the school district level. Although there were sufficient school-level data to calculate student racial/ethnic enrollment figures for all 100 largest school districts, reporting from schools in other districts was not complete enough to be able to calculate national distributions. National racial/ethnic data are therefore taken from the most currently available (fall, 1992) Office for Civil Rights (OCR) report.

Asian/Pacific Islanders (table 9). In 24 districts, no single racial/ethnic group comprises more than 50 percent of the student population.

All 100 school districts report approximately 50 to 70 percent of their expenditures going towards instruction (computed from table 10). The District of Columbia has the lowest percentage of its expenditures going to instruction at 48.4 percent, and the Puerto Rico Department of Education has the highest with 69.4 percent.

Membership Trends

The largest twenty school districts in the United States have for the most part remained relatively stable in size over the past 7 years, although there are some exceptions. When 1993-94 membership is compared with that of 1986-87 (table C):

- Clark County School District, Nevada went from the 19th largest district in 1986-87 to the 11th largest in 1993-94. Orange County, Florida, showed similar gains: moving from its 1986-87 position as the 27th in size to the 19th in 1993-94. Three other districts in Florida (Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach County) also showed over 25 percent increases in student membership.
- Some of the districts serving large cities have experienced losses or remained essentially flat, with Detroit and Chicago registering declines over 5 percent. Puerto Rico, not a city district, indicates a 7.1 percent loss over the 7-year period.
- The 20 largest districts, in both years, accounted for approximately 12 percent of the students in the Nation's public elementary and secondary schools. In the fall of 1986, these 20 districts enrolled 4,850,406 pupils out of a national total (including outlying areas) of 40,499,050. In 1993-94, they had 5,216,541 students out of 44,077,650.

Methodology

The primary source of data for this report is the 1993-94 Common Core of Data (CCD). Information was reported to NCES by state education agencies in the spring of 1994. There are four CCD surveys collecting basic descriptive data on public education in the nation: nonfiscal data are gathered through the school ("Public School Universe" survey), local education agency ("Education Agency Universe" survey), and state forms ("State Nonfiscal Survey"); fiscal data are gathered at the state level by NCES in the National Public Education Finance Survey and at the local level in the F-33 series of the Census of Local Governments by the Governments Division of the Bureau of the Census. All responses are provided by a CCD coordinator in each state education agency. The information for the tables is taken from the "Public School Universe" and the (local) "Education Agency Universe" collections. Since the information is supplied by state education agencies, any item of data missing for one school district is generally missing for other districts in the same state. For the calculation of national or subnational averages, data were obtained from the "State Nonfiscal Survey." Wherever this alternative source has been used, the information is footnoted or explained in the text.

Response Rates

Notwithstanding the item nonresponse situations cited below, most of these data represent school-district level figures. District level data were provided by all 50 states, the District of Columbia, and five outlying areas: American Samoa, Guam, Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands.

Item Nonresponse

There were some items for which data were not available at the desired levels. The following nonresponse situations in the CCD school and agency universe surveys relate to information presented in this report: No teacher counts—Massachusetts (school universe); no high school graduate counts—Washington (agency universe); no special education Individual Education Plan counts (or zero entered in every record)—Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio, and Puerto Rico; no Free Lunch Eligible Data—Alabama, Arizona, Illinois, Kentucky, Massachusetts, New Mexico, New York, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, and Washington; no fiscal data—Puerto Rico (agency universe).

Data for the national totals were taken from the public school and agency surveys except in the case of teacher totals for Massachusetts and graduate counts for Washington. The state totals for these two states were obtained from the 1993-94 State Nonfiscal survey. For all school districts other than the Boston School District the teacher count was taken from the school universe; because of non-reporting at the school level, the Boston School District teacher count was obtained from the agency universe. For all school districts other than the Seattle School District, graduate counts were obtained from the agency universe. The number of graduates for the Seattle School District was obtained by directly contacting the school district. Fiscal data for Puerto Rico were taken from the 1992-93 National Public Education Finance Survey.

Definitions

Current expenditures—Funds spent for operating local public schools, including such items as salaries for school personnel, student transportation, school books and materials, and energy costs, but excluding capital outlay and interest on school debt.

Graduates—Students who completed the course of public elementary and secondary education offered by the school district and received a regular high school diploma as defined by state law or policy during the period September 1992 through August 1993.

Per pupil expenditure—Total current expenditure for public elementary and secondary education in a state divided by the student membership. The numbers reported here, based on membership, can be expected to be smaller than per pupil expenditures based on average daily attendance, because the membership counts are generally larger than average daily attendance. As with pupil-teacher ratio, the average reported here does not reflect variations across school districts, grade levels, or programs.

Public school—An institution which provides educational services and has the following characteristics:

- Has one or more grade groups (prekindergarten through grade 12) or is ungraded;
- Has one or more teachers to give instruction;
- Is located in one or more buildings or sites;
- Has an assigned administrator;
- Receives public funds as primary support;
- Is operated by an education agency.

Pupil-teacher ratio—The ratio of pupils to teachers in a school district, based on the total number of pupils and the total full-time-equivalent (FTE) number of teachers reported in the schools associated with the school district.

Pupils in membership—Count of all students whose names have been entered on the roll, minus those whose names have been withdrawn, on or before the closest school day to October 1. Membership counts at the district level may include students for whom the district is providing educational services through some other agency or institution.

Regular school—A public elementary/secondary school that does not focus primarily on vocational, special, or alternative education.

Revenues—Additions to assets which do not incur an obligation that must be met at some future date, do not represent exchanges of fixed assets, and are available for expenditure by the local education agencies in the state. Revenues include funds from local, intermediate, state, and federal sources.

Schools having membership—Schools at which students are counted for administrative purposes, even though the students may attend one or more other schools for all or part of their school day.

Teachers—Sum of full-time-equivalent (FTE) count of teachers by school for all schools in a school district.

Basic Tables

Table 1 presents basic data—numbers of students receiving educational services, teachers, 1993 graduates, and schools—for each of the 100 largest districts. Also shown in table 1 is information to fully identify each school district, since the name of the district is not always sufficient for this purpose. On this and all the other tables, the districts are shown in decreasing order of size (pupils in membership as of October 1993). Since the districts are arrayed by number of pupils, it is easy to note the differences in the numbers of teachers, graduates, and schools as they relate to districts of similar size. For example, although the Puerto Rico Department of Education has fewer students than the Los Angeles Unified School District, it has more graduates. Prince George's County Public Schools, Maryland, though smaller in size than Duval County School District, Florida, has more graduates and teachers. For all school districts other than the Boston School District the teacher count was derived from the school universe. The Boston School District teacher count was taken from the agency universe. The number of graduates for the Seattle School District was obtained by directly contacting the school district, whereas for the remaining districts data were obtained from the agency universe.

Table 2 shows the number of schools in the 100 largest districts, by type of school. All but one of the districts (Shelby County School District) have specialized schools devoted to special, vocational, or alternative education. The numbers of students assigned to these schools are given in table 3. It should be noted that students attending a specialized school are often counted at their nonspecialized (regular) home school rather than at the specialized school they attend. It can be seen from these tables that districts vary widely in their use of specialized versus general schools in educating students with special needs. The number of students having Individual Education Programs (IEP) in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act-Part B, is shown in the last column of table 3.

In tables 4 through 9 only schools with student membership, or *regular* schools having membership, as specified in table 5, are used in the data sets from which these tables are derived. In tables 5 through 9 this was required to determine pupil membership by grade in order to determine school categories.

Table 4 provides information on school characteristics in the 100 districts by displaying an array showing school size (pupils in membership) at different percentile levels, as well as mean school size for each district (computed using regular schools having membership). According to this table, median school size ranges from a low of 357 pupils (Puerto Rico Department of Education) to a high of 1,116 (Gwinnett County, Georgia) for these districts. The largest school in these districts, and also the largest school in the United States, is the 4,986-student J. F. Kennedy High School in the New York City Public Schools. Looking more closely at New York City, the table shows that 25 percent of the schools have a pupil membership of 594 or fewer, and another 25 percent have a membership of 1159 or more. Dividing all the students in regular schools by the number of such schools yields a mean, or average, size of 1,010.1 students. If all the regular schools in New York City were listed by size, the school at the mid-point on the list would have 841 pupils in membership. The median, therefore, is 841.

In table 5, data are given on the number of students assigned to graded (three categories) and ungraded classes. In accounting for their students, 41 of the 100 largest districts assign all students to numbered grades and 59 use the "ungraded" status for students in some settings, such as special education, vocational education, and other specialized and alternative programs. In this table, students assigned to all types of schools are counted in the grade for which they are reported.

People frequently want to know how many "elementary schools" and "high schools" there are in any selection of school districts. Table 6 deals with these questions. Since nearly every conceivable grade span is found among the 14,000 plus schools in the 100 largest districts, the following four categories are used: primary (low grade of prekindergarten to 3; high grade up to 8), middle (low grade 4 to 7; high grade 4 to 9), high (low grade 7 to 12; high grade 12), and other (all other configurations). Although 92 of these school districts have some schools in the "other" category, only in the Puerto Rico school system is the *number* very high (232, or 14.8 percent). Several districts that have fewer pupils than Puerto Rico, however, have high *percentages* of schools in this category. Some districts in this group are Volusia County, Florida (19.4 percent); Northside ISD, Texas (15.8 percent); San Juan Unified, California (14.9 percent); and Fort Worth ISD, Texas and Lee County School District, Florida (13.2 percent).

Table 7 shows median pupil-teacher ratios for the schools found in the categories established in table 6. Since teacher counts by school were not available for Boston, no pupil-teacher ratio could be calculated for the schools in the district. Among the 100 largest districts, the median pupil-teacher ratio for all schools in a district varied from 14.6:1 in Newark, New Jersey to 38.3:1 in Ysleta ISD, Texas.

Table 8 gives the number of schools in each district in five categories of minority concentration, as well as the overall minority student percentage for each district as a whole. In this report, minority is defined as all other than white non-Hispanic. Among the 20 largest districts, it is not uncommon to have two-thirds or more of the schools with more than 60 percent minority membership. In 1993-94, out of the 20 largest there were 11 such districts. Table 8 shows that except for the Broward County School District, Florida, 9 of the 10 largest school districts have more than 75 percent minority students. For example, 88.6 percent of the City of Chicago School District's students are minorities.

Whereas table 8 dealt with the number of schools in each district having a strong minority presence of any kind, table 9 shows the percentage of students in the entire district by specific racial/ethnic category. The City of Chicago shows 55.6 percent non-Hispanic black students, 29.6 percent Hispanic students, and 11.4 non-Hispanic white students. Table 9 also shows the number of students eligible for free lunch. Responses in this data category were available for 85 districts out of the 100 largest. Among these districts, the percentages of students eligible for free lunch under a Federal program range from 7.3 (Chesterfield County, Virginia) to 78.7 percent (San Antonio ISD, Texas).

Table 10, dealing with school district revenues and expenditures, is based on fiscal year 1993 local government financial data collected by the Governments Division of the U.S. Census

Bureau. It indicates the amount of revenue received, by source—local, state, and Federal—and current expenditures for instruction and all other, plus current expenditures per pupil in membership for the fiscal year in question. Data for Puerto Rico were obtained from the NCES *National Public Education Financial Survey*. Among the 100 largest school districts, Newark, New Jersey, has the highest expenditure per pupil (\$9,501), and Puerto Rico Department of Education, the lowest (\$2,052). Overall, table 10 shows five school districts with per pupil expenditure greater than \$7,000 and five school districts with per pupil expenditure less than \$3,000.
