ABSTRACT

The National Household Education Survey (NHES) is a data collection system of the National Center for Education Statistics that is designed to provide information about educational issues best addressed through contacting households rather than institutions. In 1995, as in 1991, one of the components of this telephone survey was a study of adult education courses taken by respondents. For the 1995 survey, 19,722 interviews were completed with participants and nonparticipants in adult education. To provide data users with the ability to use the information collected on degree or certification courses, work-related courses, or courses for personal interests, the subject matter of courses was coded. A coding scheme containing 43 courses was developed, based on the Department of Education's College Course Map and the work of C. Adelman. The course code merge files for which this user guide has been developed contain the course code variables for each reported course. It is important to note that the course code merge files cannot be used by themselves for any analysis. Instead, they are designed to be used with the Adult Education public data files. This guide contains the following sections: (1) Background; (2) Adult Education Courses; (3) Course Codes; (4) Merge Files; (5) Statistical Analysis System example. Appendixes describe the course code merge file layout in position order and present the merge file codebook. (Contains five references.) (SLD)



Background

The National Household Education Survey (NHES) is a data collection system of the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES), which has as its legislative mission the collection and publication of data on the condition of education in the Nation. The NHES is specifically designed to support this mission by providing information on educational issues that are best addressed by contacting households rather than schools or other educational institutions. The NHES provides descriptive data on the educational activities of the U.S. population and offers policymakers, researchers, and educators a variety of statistics on the condition of education in the United States.

The NHES is a telephone survey of the noninstitutionalized, civilian population of the United States. Households are selected for the survey using random-digit-dial (RDD) methods, and data are collected using computer-assisted telephone interviewing (CATI) procedures. From 45,000 to 64,000 households are screened for each administration, and individuals within households who meet predetermined criteria are sampled for more detailed or extended interviews. The data are weighted to permit estimates of the entire U.S. population. The NHES survey for a given year typically consists of a set of screening questions (Screener) collecting household composition and demographic data, and extended interviews on two substantive components addressing education-related topics. In order to assess data item reliability and inform future NHES surveys, each administration also includes data quality studies such as reinterviews with a subsample of respondents.

The primary purpose of the NHES is to conduct repeated measurements of the same phenomena at different points in time and one-time surveys on topics of interest to the Department of Education. Throughout its history, the NHES has collected data in ways that permit estimates to be tracked across time. This includes repeating topical components on a rotating basis in order to provide comparative data across survey years. In addition, each administration of the NHES has benefited from experiences with previous cycles, resulting in improvement to the survey procedures and content. Thus, while the survey affords the opportunity for tracking phenomena across time, it is also dynamic in addressing new issues and including conceptual and methodological refinements.

Full-scale implementations of the NHES have been conducted in 1991, 1993, 1995, and 1996. Topics addressed by the NHES:91 were early childhood education and adult education. The NHES:93 collected information about school readiness and school safety and discipline. The 1991 components were repeated for the NHES:95, addressing early childhood program participation and adult education. Both components underwent substantial redesign to incorporate new issues and develop new measurement approaches. In the NHES:96, the topical components were parent/family involvement in education and civic involvement, and an expanded screening approach provided state-level estimates of public library use by households.

In the NHES:91, 60,314 households were screened and adult education interviews were completed with 12,568 persons, including interviews with 9,774 adults who participated in adult education in the previous 12 months and 2,794 interviews with adults who did not participate. More details on the NHES:91 data collection and public use data files are given in *National Household Education Survey of 1991: Adult Education Data File User's Manual* (Brick et al. 1992). In the NHES:95, screening interviews were completed with 45,465 households, and 19,722 adult education interviews were completed, including 11,713 AE participants and 8,009 AE nonparticipants. More details on the NHES:95 data collection and public use data files are given in *National Household Education Survey of 1995: Adult Education Data File User's Manual* (Collins et al. 1996).



Adult Education Courses

Adult education encompasses a wide variety of courses and classes taken by adults through schools, colleges, businesses, labor or professional groups, churches, and other community organizations. These may be related to basic reading and math skills, preparing to take a high school equivalency test, English as a Second Language (ESL), getting a vocational certificate or college degree, preparing for a job or keeping up to date at work, or personal interest.

In the NHES:91 AE component, respondents reported their four most recent courses, not counting courses they took as full-time students. These courses could be in any of the areas described above.

In the NHES:95 AE component, a different approach to collecting information on AE activities was used. Specifically, information on AE activities was collected by asking about six general areas of adult education:

- English as a Second Language (ESL) courses;
- Basic skills education or GED preparation courses;
- Courses taken for credential programs, such as college degrees or vocational/technical diplomas;
- Apprenticeship programs;
- Courses taken for career- or job-related purposes; or
- Other formal structured courses where there was an instructor, also called personal interest or personal development courses.

Information was collected on individual courses in three of these six areas: courses taken on a part-time basis toward a college degree or a vocational certificate; work-related courses; and other formal structured courses (personal interest or personal development).

Course Codes

In order to provide data users with enhanced ability to use the course information for analysis, it was decided to code the subject matter of AE courses for the NHES:91 and the NHES:95. Supplementary data files for each survey year include the codes for the courses taken. A course coding scheme containing 43 coding categories was developed for the purpose of coding the courses reported in the NHES AE components. This coding scheme is an aggregated form of the College Course Map (CCM) (Adelman 1995); hence, the conceptual foundation for this coding scheme relies heavily on the work of Cliff Adelman. Detailed information on the coding scheme and the decision rules used in coding the AE courses is found in a manual developed for this purpose: National Household Education Survey of 1995: Adult Education Course Coding Manual (Kim et al. 1997).

Merge Files

The course code merge files contain the course code variables for each reported course. It is important to note that the course code merge files <u>cannot</u> be used by themselves for any analysis. Instead, these merge files are designed to be used with the AE public data files (i.e., NHES:91 Adult file, NHES:91 Course file, or NHES:95 AE file). The table below shows the relationships between the NHES public data files and course code merge files. The National Household Education Survey Data Files and Electronic CodeBook (ECB) are provided on CD-ROM. A subdirectory on the CD-ROM (\CRSMERGE)

contains the course code data files. In addition, the subdirectory contains merge programs for SAS, SPSS for DOS, and SPSS for Windows, and documentation on the file. This documentation is in WordPerfect 5.1 for DOS; however, Word for Windows, another commonly used word processing program, is able to import WordPerfect 5.1 files.

A brief explanation of how to merge the course code files to the AE public data files is provided below. In this example, the NHES:95 AE SAS merge program is used. The SPSS merge programs can be used in the same way as this example substituting the desired course code merge files and the NHES AE public data sets.

- 1. Using the National Household Education Survey Data Files and Electronic Codebook on CD-ROM, select the variables of interest for your analysis and extract the SAS command file to create the analysis data file. Be sure that the SAS extract file includes the full sample weight (AEWEIGHT for the NHES:95). Refer to NHES:91/93/95/96 Electronic CodeBook (ECB) User's Guide (Collins and Chandler 1997) for details on using the Electronic CodeBook.
- 2. Add the SAS merge program for the NHES:95 course codes (CC95.SAS) to the end of the SAS command file you created from the Electronic CodeBook.
- 3. Modify your SAS program (e.g., PROC statements) to include the analyses of interest to you.
