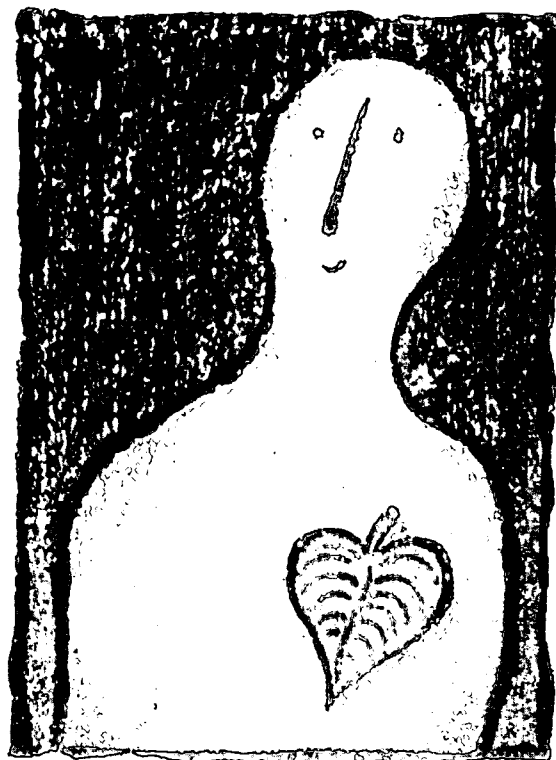
ABSTRACT

This document represents an extensively revised and updated United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) Directory for Environmental Training Worldwide. Part II: FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Kindly find below information on possible sources of financial aid for those candidates wishing to pursue environmental studies abroad.

General: The acquisition of fellowships is often a lengthy process. It is therefore most important that applicants approach donor agencies, preferably several at the same time, at a very early stage. Fellowships are sometimes allocated to governments, who then nominate candidates. The standard procedure for this is for an applicant to request his/her employer to nominate him/her to the pertinent government office which finally nominates the candidate to a fellowship donor. If applying directly for external funding, you should instead contact the relevant office or representative of a funding agency or the diplomatic mission of a country providing financial assistance. In all cases, the application should be supported by letters of endorsement from appropriate authorities and letters of acceptance from the university or training institution.

European Committee: Countries signatory to the Lomé Convention receive fellowships for their citizens from the European Community (EC) Development Fund (EDF). In countries that have relations with the EC, the EC representative can provide information on how to apply for EDF fellowships through the local government agency appointed to promote and nominate candidates. With rare exceptions, EC fellowships are granted only to nationals of ACP (African, Caribbean and Pacific) countries.

Netherlands Fellowship Programme: A limited number of fellowships is available within the Netherlands Fellowship Programme for studies in the Netherlands. These fellowships are made available by the Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs through the Netherlands Fellowship Programme. Priority is given to certain countries, to

forms are available from the Netherlands Government representatives in your country. Employers should ask the government office concerned to request the application forms on behalf of the candidates. Other Dutch scholarship funds include those awarded by the Netherlands Ministry of Education and Science. For further information about the latter, see the brochure 'Basic data', published by the Netherlands Universities Foundation for International Cooperation (NUFFIC), P.O. Box 29777, 2502 LT The Hague. This brochure is also sent to the Dutch embassies and consulates.

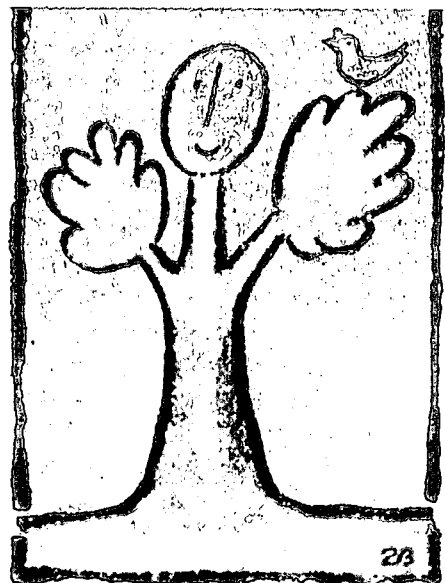
