ABSTRACT

This is the seventh annual report on transfers, degrees, and certificates awarded by California Community Colleges. Highlights include: (1) during the 1998-99 academic year, California community colleges awarded a total 64,030 Associate of Arts/Associate of Science (AA/AS) degrees and another 27,660 certificates requiring 18 or more semester units. Compared with the prior year, this represents a 3,022 (5.0%) increase in degrees and a 2,269 (8.9%) increase in certificates; (2) full-year transfers to the University of California totaled 10,161, a decrease of 49 (0.4%); (3) full-year transfers to the California State University amounted to 44,989, a decrease of 557 (1.2%) over the prior academic year; (4) districts awarding the largest number of AA/AS degrees included Los Angeles (4,872), Los Rios (2,510), and Ventura (2,409); (5) of the 27,660 certificates awarded, 13,951 (50%) required the equivalent of 30 to 60 credit units, followed by 10,950 (40%) of 15 to 29 credit units; (6) more women than men earned degrees and certificates; (7) women earned 55,430 (61%) of the degrees and certificates awarded, compared with 35,313 (39%) for men (after proration of unknowns); (8) the number of degrees and certificates earned by race/ethnic categories were: Whites, 42,790 (50%); Hispanics, 18,630 (22%); Asian/Pacific Islanders, 11,206 (13%); and Blacks, 6,747 (8%). P r e f a c e

This is the seventh annual report on the number of transfers, degrees, and certificates awarded by California Community Colleges. Except for the transfer information, this report is based on data provided by districts to the Chancellor's Office Management Information System (COMIS) for the following data elements (as defined in the *Data Element Dictionary*): SP01, Student Program Identifier; SP02, Student Program Award; SP04, Student Gender; SP05, Student Ethnicity; GI01, District-College Identifier; GI03, Term Identifier; and CB03, Course Program Code.

The purpose of this report is two-fold. First, it provides feedback to districts and colleges on data reported through the COMIS process. District staff should determine if the information in this report accurately reflects their college's actual performance. If discrepancies are identified, district MIS staff should be contacted for assistance in finding the source of reporting or processing error. Any errors identified should be corrected for the next reporting cycle. Second, this report serves as a reference document on how well colleges are doing in preparing students for transfer and awarding degrees and certificates—two important performance goals within the *Partnership for Excellence* program funded by the state Legislature in 1998-99. Increasingly, state and federal accountability reports are focusing on transfers, degrees, and certificates as important measures of performance. It is hoped that annual publication of these data will not only improve reporting but encourage colleges to use this information for instructional improvement through institutional research, master planning, program review, assessment studies, and accreditation self-studies.

This report is similar in format and content to prior-year reports. Table 1 displays the total number of degrees and types of certificates offered, by district and college. Also included in this table are district counts for total Attendance FTES to serve as a reference point for district size. Table 2 shows distributions for the number of degrees and certificates awarded by gender and race/ethnicity. Tables 3A and Table 3B show the total district and college awards in each of the two-digit TOP (Taxonomy of Programs) Code discipline categories. Table 4 shows data aggregated at the statewide level for degrees and types of certificates awarded in the various six-digit TOP Code. Table 5 illustrates the three most recent years of data on full-year transfers for each district and college to the University of California and the California State University. The source for this transfer information is the California Postsecondary Education Commission's report, *Student Profiles* (April 1998).

Executive Summary

During the 1998-99 academic year, California community colleges awarded a total 64,030 Associate of Arts/Science (AA/AS) degrees and another 27,660 certificates requiring 18 or more semester units. Compared to the prior year, this represents a 3,022 (5.0%) increase in degrees and a 2,269 (8.9%) increase in certificates. Full-year transfers to the University of California totalled 10,161, a decrease of 49 (0.4%). Full-year transfers to the California State University amounted to 44,989, a decrease of 557 (1.2%) over the prior academic year. Districts awarding the largest number of AA/AS degrees included Los Angeles (4,872), Los Rios (2,510), Ventura (2,409), Coast (2,123), Sonoma (1,979), San Diego (1,848), Foothill-DeAnza (1,808), and State Center (1,581).

Of the 27,660 certificates awarded, 13,951 (50%) required the equivalent of 30 to 60 credit units, followed by 10,950 (40%) of 15 to 29 credit units, and 2,759 (10%) of 60+ credit units in length.

More women than men earned degrees and certificates. Women earned 55,430 (61%) of the degrees and certificates awarded compared to 35,313 (39%) for men (after proration of unknowns).

The number of degrees and certificates earned by race/ethnic categories were: Whites, 42,790 (50%); Hispanics, 18,630 (22%); Asians/Pacific Islanders, 11,206 (13%); and Blacks, 6,747 (8%).

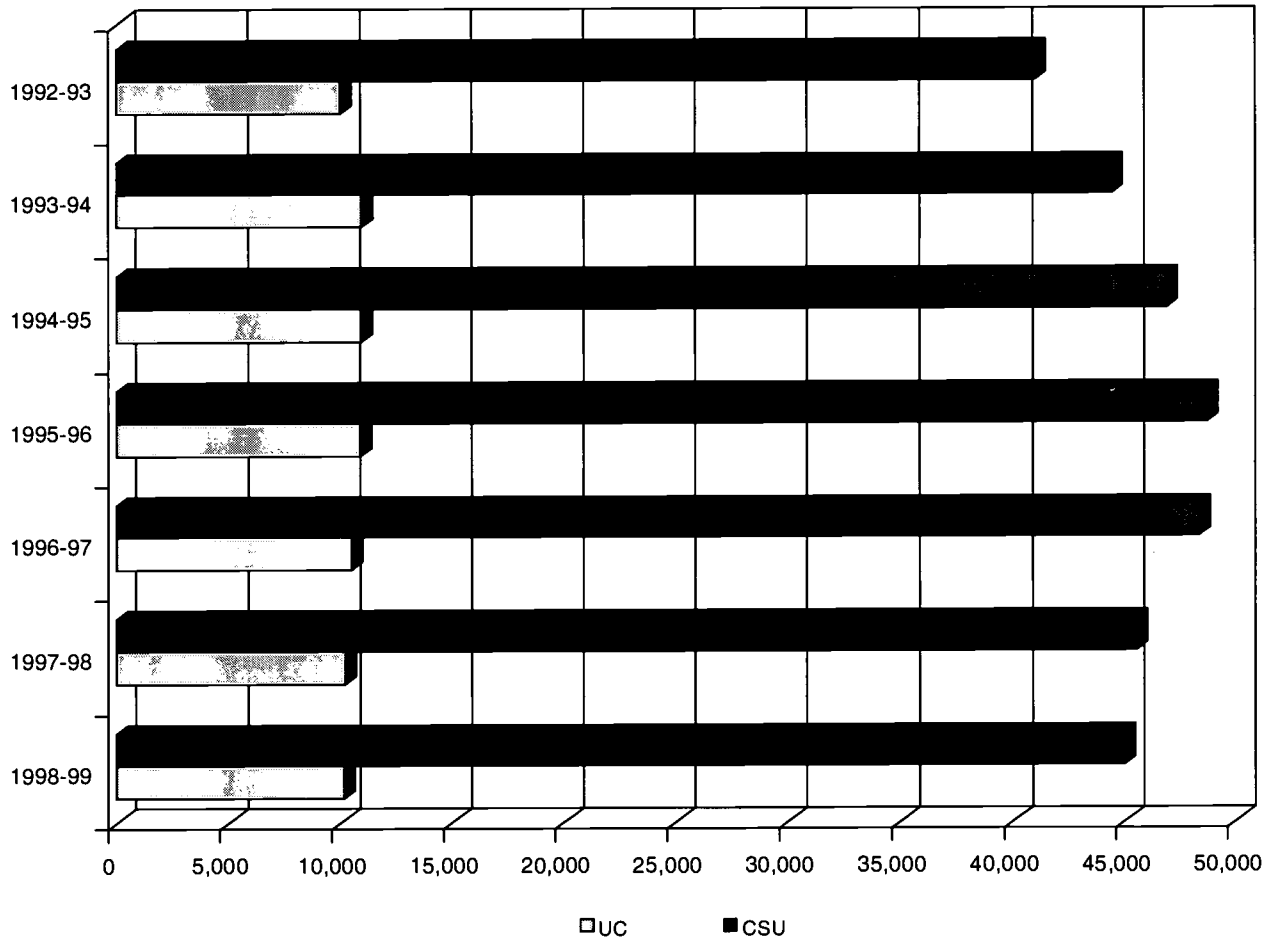
