## ABSTRACT

This matrix provides information on early childhood training and technical assistance services in Illinois. Parts of the document are presented in grid form so that information can be compared across programs. First, information is provided on the following training and technical assistance providers: Child Care Resource & Referral (CCR&R/Illinois Network CCRRA), STARNet, Quality Network (Q-Net), Quality Improvement Center/Disabilities, Early Childhood Block Grant (ECBG) Professional Development, and Provider Connections. Information is then provided on Illinois state agencies: Illinois Department of Human Services (IDHS) Bureau of Child Care, IDHS Bureau of Early Intervention, IDHS Collaboration Office, IDHS Bureau of Family Nutrition, IDHS Community Health Nursing, and Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) Early Childhood Block Grant. Information is then provided on Illinois early childhood organizations and associations: Illinois Association for the Education of Young Children, Chicago Metro Association for the Education of Young Children, Sharing a Vision Illinois Division of Early Childhood, and the Illinois Head Start Association. The remainder of the document then provides a map of the Illinois Child Care Resource & Referral System; a membership roster for the Illinois Network of Child Care Resource & Referral Agencies; contact information for provider service community partners of the Day Care Action Council of Illinois; a map of the STARNet regions and contact information for personnel; and a directory of child care nurse consultants.
