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ABSTRACT

This roster contains detailed data from the annual Survey of Enrollments and Degrees. The survey was conducted in the 2002-2003 academic year. It includes all degree-granting physics departments in the United states. Presented in this roster are the data reported by those departments for their 2001-2002 introductory course enrollments, 2002-200 degrees, and their fall 2002 undergraduate major and graduate student enrollments. Of the 766 degree-granting physics departments, 717 (94%) contributed to the data supplied in this year's roster. In fall 2002, there were 11,995 undergraduate physics majors in their junior or senior years, and 6,060 of them were from other countries. For the 2001-2002 academic year, 4,305 bachelor's degrees were granted, with 657 exiting master's degrees, and 1,095 PhDs. Enrollment is given for physics and astronomy at junior and senior year fore each responding institution, and the numbers of foreign students are also shown by institution. (SLD)

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ROSTER OF PHYSICS DEPARTMENTS WITH ENROLLMENT AND DEGREE DATA, 2002.

This roster contains detailed data from the annual Survey of Enrollments and Degrees. The survey was conducted during the 2002-03 academic year and consists of all degree-granting physics departments in the United States. Presented in this roster are the data reported by those departments for their 2001-02 introductory course enrollments, 2001-02 degrees and their fall 2002 undergraduate major and graduate student enrollments.

The introductory course enrollment totals listed for each department represent the number of students who took their first term of introductory level physics, astronomy or physical science. Departments were instructed not to include enrollments for courses that were a continuation of a sequence.

Of the 766 degree-granting physics departments, 717 (94%) contributed to the data supplied in this year's roster. Data are not presented for departments who did not contribute to the study. Some departments only supplied partial data and consequently have an incomplete entry.

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Notations used in this roster:

- m* Department grants a masters as its highest physics degree (N=68).
- p* Department grants a PhD as its highest physics degree (N=185).
- GRADUATE DEPT ONLY Department has no undergraduate program in physics (N=7).
- FIRST YEAR This column includes graduate students who were new to the department in the fall 2002 as well as students who entered the department in the previous winter, spring and summer.
- EXITING MASTERS This column includes masters degrees from both masters-granting and doctoral-granting departments whose students are leaving that department with a masters.
- Data for this field were not provided.

The totals presented in the table below represent all physics departments. This includes data from the responding departments as well as estimated data for the non-responding departments. These estimates were derived from a department's response to the survey in a previous year.
