### 2014 Cohort Graduation and Dropout Rate Report

### State Cohort Graduation Rate Highlights

- 83% is the statewide graduation rate for 2014.
- The graduation rate increased by 2% from 2013 to 2014.
- Since 2008, the graduation rate has increased by 14%.
- 35,763 students graduated from high school in 2014.

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### Background

The four-year cohort rate for the 2013-2014 school year includes all students who started ninth grade in the 2010-2011 school year, plus students who transferred into the Utah public education system in grade 9 or higher. The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) requires the State to calculate a four-year cohort rate to compare Utah's graduation rate with other states. Utah implemented this federally defined cohort graduation rate in 2008, and historical information from these years can be found at the following URL: <a href="http://schools.utah.gov/data/Reports/Graduation-Dropout.aspx">http://schools.utah.gov/data/Reports/Graduation-Dropout.aspx</a>. This four-year cohort rate is used for all school accountability calculations.

There are four outcome categories in the cohort rate calculation:

- Graduates
- Dropouts
- Continuing Students
- Other Completers

The "graduate" category only includes students who have earned a basic high school diploma or an adult education secondary diploma (Carnegie Units) achieved by September 30 following the end of their cohort school year. Students considered "other completers" include those students who completed the General Education Development test (GED) or a Certificate of Completion, and students with disabilities who participated in the Utah Alternate Assessment (UAA). Students considered to be "continuing students" are students with disabilities (continued enrollment allowed until age 22), or those who transfer to higher education or the Utah College of Applied Technology (UCAT) without first receiving a high school diploma. The "dropout" category includes students who have not completed graduation requirements, such as those who have withdrawn, dropped out, or been expelled. Under the federal requirements, students who take longer than four years after entering ninth grade to receive their regular high school diploma are also considered dropouts.



### **Longitudinal Comparisons**

Utah's graduation rate has increased by 8 percentage points over the last five years. In the same period, the dropout rate has declined by 8 percentage points. Continuing students and other completers have remained fairly constant and constitute about 2-3% of the cohort.



Economically disadvantaged, English language learners, and students with disabilities have all made gains in their graduation rates.







